

## Scholarship Application Tips for Incoming Freshman

1. You may apply for both admissions and scholarships to Texas A&M University at <http://www.applytexas.org>.
2. Do not wait to apply for scholarships! (You do not have to be admitted to the University to apply for scholarships.) If you apply late, you run the risk of not completing your application in time for full consideration. Application submission, official high school transcript, official SAT or ACT scores with writing section, and application fee must be received by Admissions and records for scholarship consideration.
3. Remember to write down your 6-digit application ID#. This number will serve as your ID for both your admissions and your scholarship applications. You will need it to access your application and verify submission.
4. We encourage all applicants to answer all income related questions. Leaving any income questions blank on the scholarship application may disqualify you from consideration for some scholarships.
5. Please review the Special Instructions page before you begin your scholarship application.
6. You are required to submit Essays A&B. Completion of the Personal Essay is highly recommended for additional scholarship consideration. Essays should not exceed the space allocated. ONLY the first submission of essays will be considered. Re-submissions will not be read. A paper resume cannot substitute for data-entry on activities, awards, and employment information requested on ApplyTexas application. No corrections or additions can be made to the scholarship application once submitted.
7. Saving an application is not the same as submitting an application. To be considered for admissions and for scholarships you must submit your application when prompted. Once your application has been submitted, you will receive a confirmation message from the ApplyTexas Application delivered to the e-mail address you provided on your application.
8. Within 2-3 days of submitting your admission application through ApplyTexas, you should receive a notice directly from Texas A&M University that your application was received. Following application processing by Texas A&M personnel, you will also receive an application acknowledgement letter with your University Identification Number (UIN) and instructions for accessing the Applicant Information System (AIS). Please monitor your admission file throughout the admissions process by logging into AIS regularly.
9. Visit [howdy.tamu.edu](http://howdy.tamu.edu) to check the status of your application.
10. Texas A&M University offices and departments will send out award notifications as awards are made. Each department's time schedule varies.
