- Updated campus design and systems for student safety and security.
- A systematic and conservative approach to meeting student needs.
- State of the art facilities to enhance award winning LISD Academic, Fine Arts and Extracurricular Programs.

March, 1972 \$1,500,000 Passed with 62% Voter Approval

November, 2002 \$12,300,000 Passed with 71% Voter Approval

November, 2009 \$42,205,000 Passed with 64% Voter Approval

Proposed November, 2018 (\$32,000,000)

- Academic/Extracurricular expansion at Lindale High School

- Student safety/security upgrades district wide
- Renovations of seating, press box, concession and restroom/sewer upgrades at Eagle Stadium

On several occasions Lindale ISD has paid cash from reserve district funds for facility expansion and renovations.

2014 – Lindale Agriculture Barn expansion (\$990,000)

2015 - Early Childhood Center classroom expansion and Gymnasium addition (\$2,400,000)
